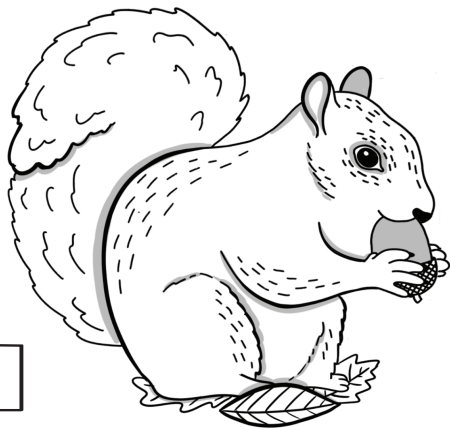


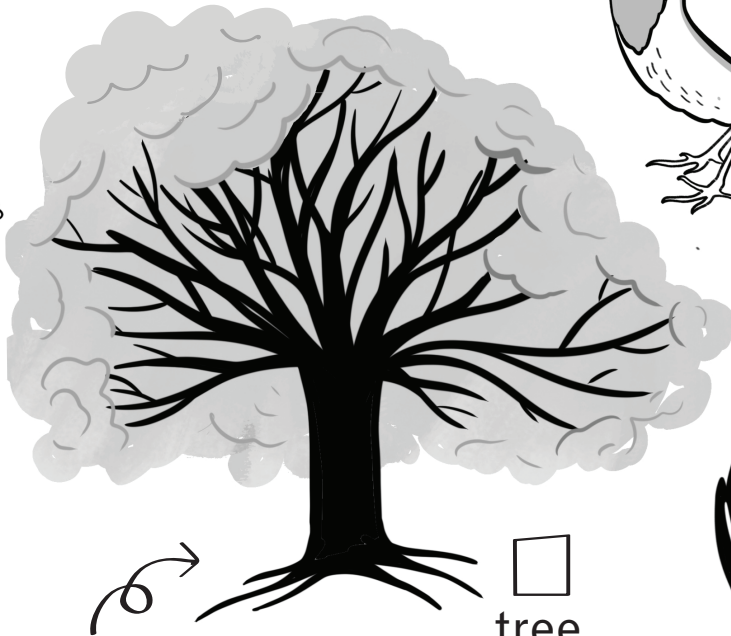
Nature Explorers

→ squirrel

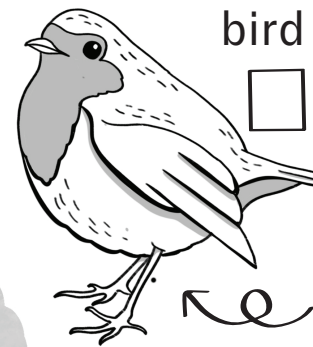


Use this space to make a leaf rubbing!

leaves

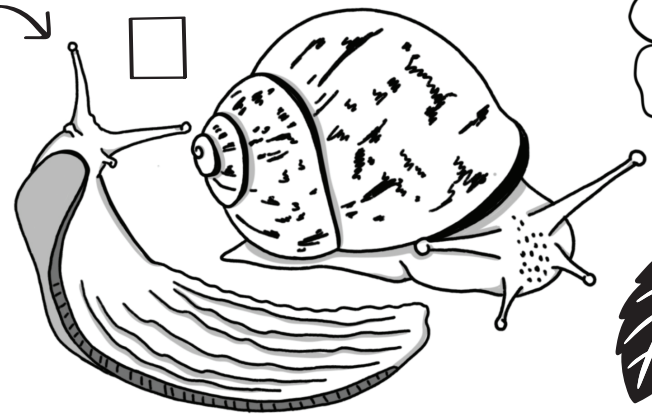


You will find lots of **English oak** trees at **Harewood**. Keep a look out for **acorns** on the ground.

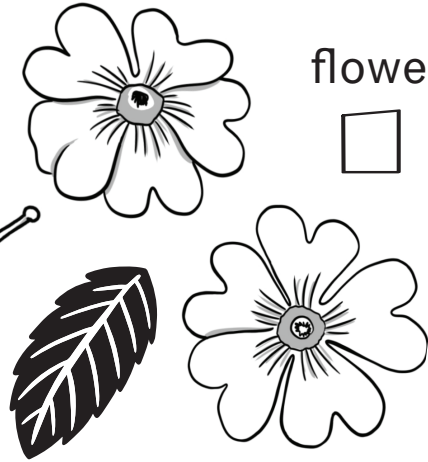

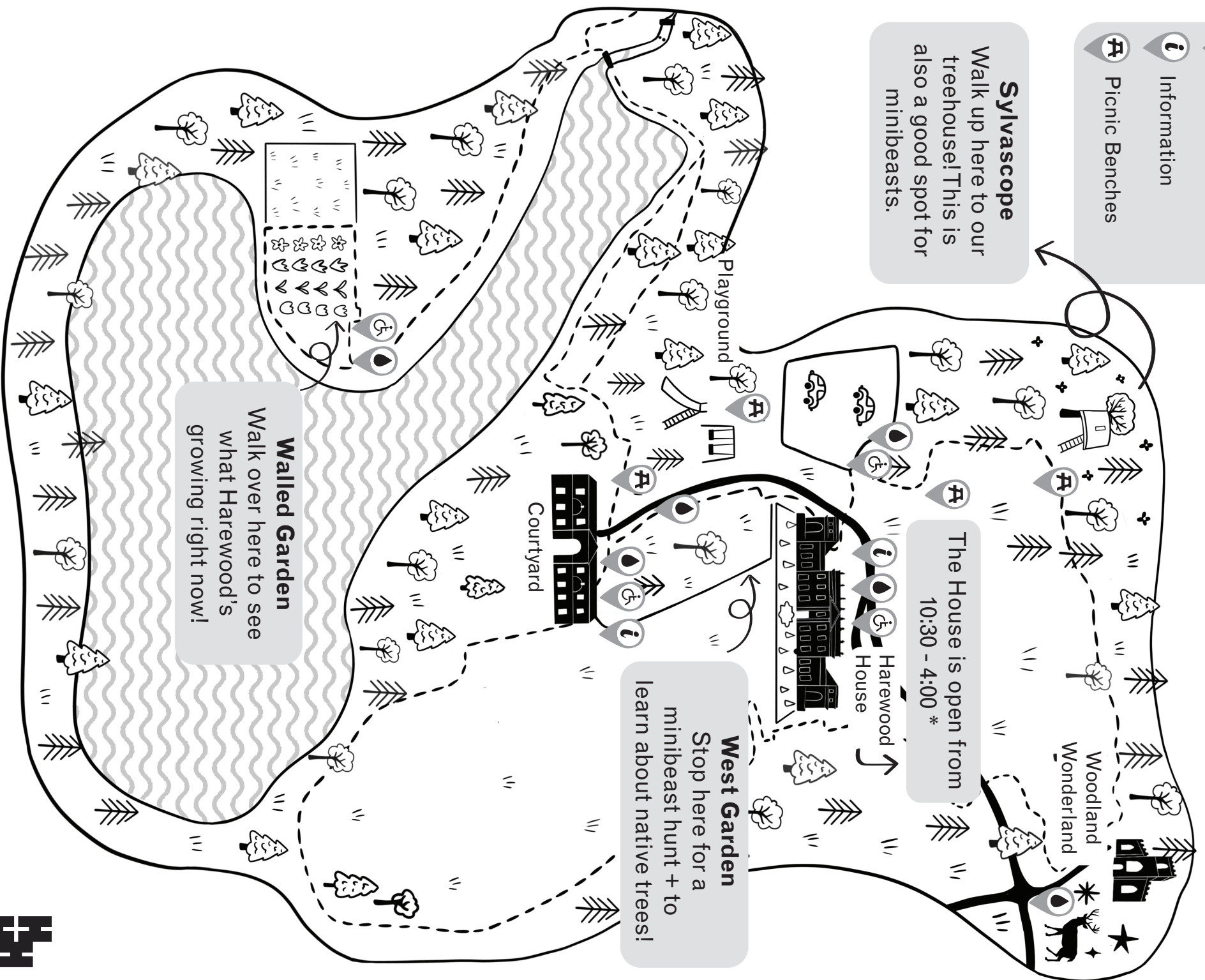
