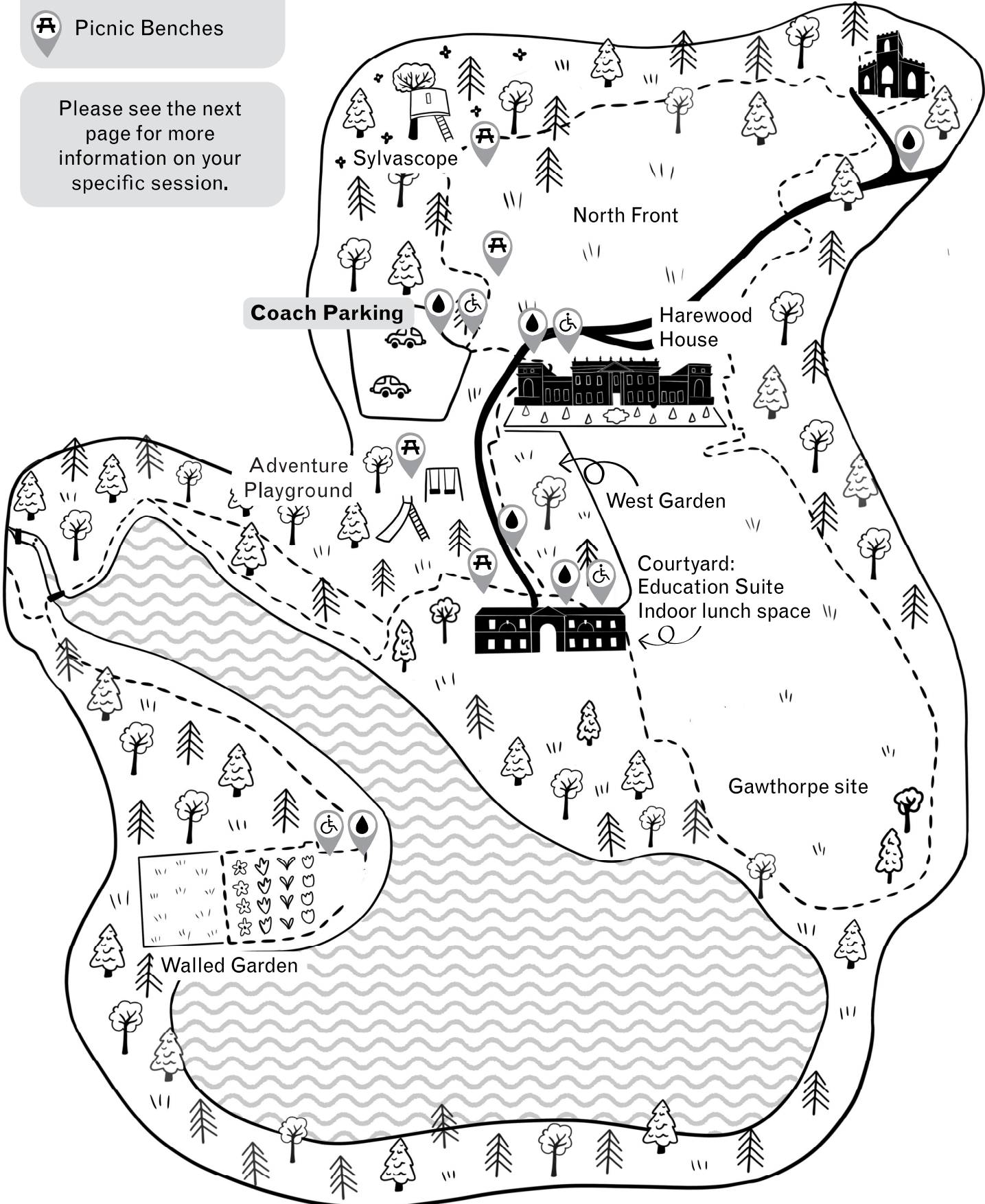

Time	Activity
10.00 - 10.15	Arrive at Harewood and park in the Coach Park
10.15 - 10.30	Visit the toilets next to the Coach Park
10.30 - 10.45	Sit at the picnic benches and grab a snack
10.45 - 11.30	Visit the West Garden and complete the Nature Explorers/Season Detectives worksheet OR Visit Sylvascope and take part in a Minibeast Hunt (make sure you check out our Bug Hotel!).
11.30 - 12.15	Find a picnic spot on the North Front (the grass opposite the House) and have lunch. The closest toilets can be found next to the Coach Park.
12.15 - 1.15	Take a stroll along the Lakeside Path in small groups and explore the Walled Garden. You will see lots of fruit/veg growing here! OR Play in our amazing Woodland Wonderland and visit the historic church.
1.15 - 1.30	Walk back along the Lakeside Path in small groups and visit the toilets at the Courtyard. OR Walk to the Courtyard and visit the toilets.
1.30 - 2.15	Visit the Adventure Playground to blow off some steam
2.15 - 2.30	Walk up to the Coach Park, visit the toilets and prepare to leave.
