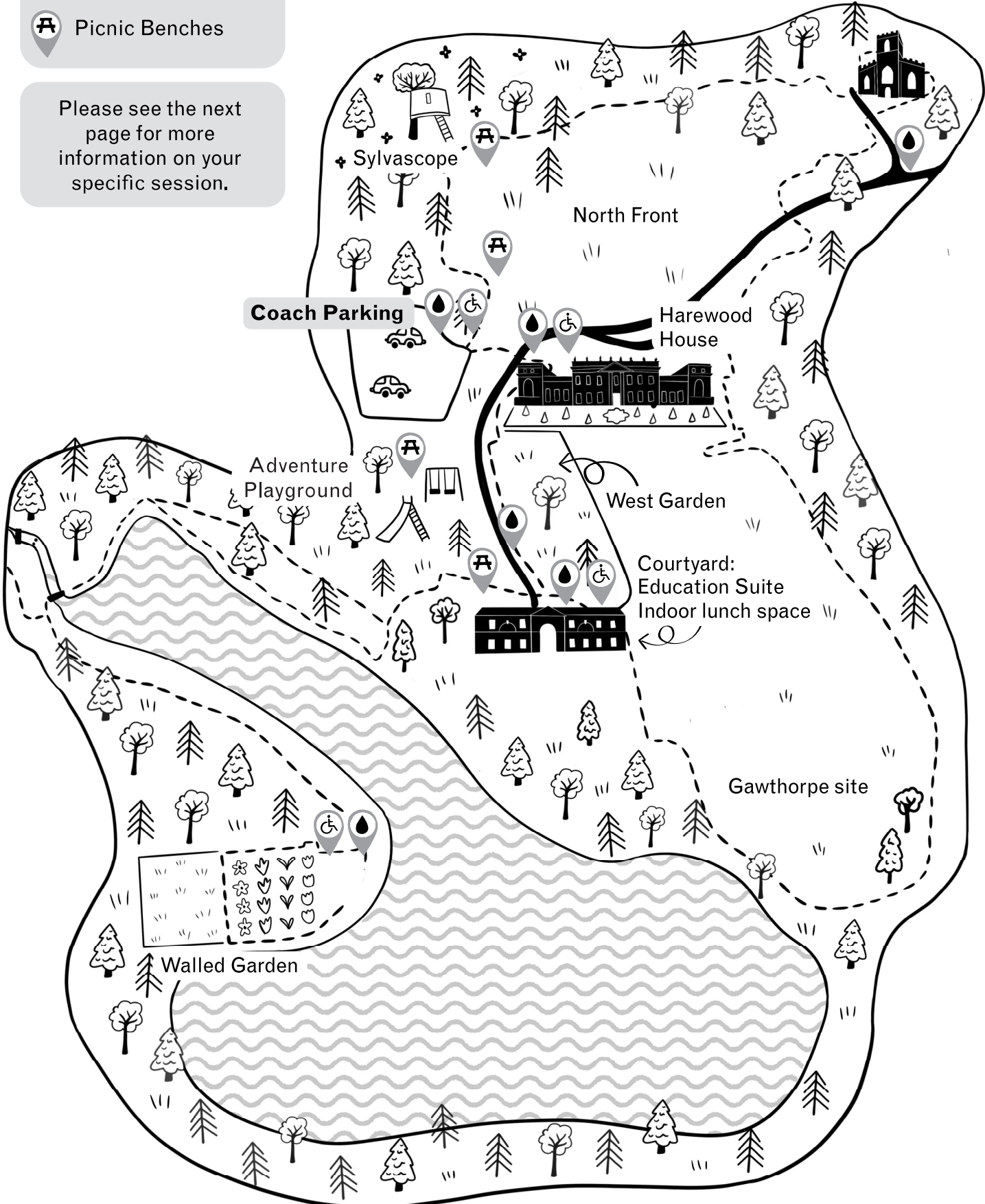

## Secondary/Higher Education Self-Guided Itinerary

Time	Group	Activity
10.00 - 10.15	all	Arrive at Harewood and park in the Coach Park. A member of the Learning Team will meet you + make sure you have everything you need for the day.
10.15 - 10.30	all	Visit the toilets next to the Coach Park and split the class into two groups
10.30 - 11.30	1	Visit the House and explore our current exhibit. When you exit at the Terrace, don't forget to take in the view!
10.30 - 11.30	2	Walk along the Lakeside and visit the Walled Garden. We have lots of fruit/veg growing - especially in the Autumn. Don't forget to stop at our Himalayan Garden on the way.
11.30 - 12.30	2	Visit the House and explore our current exhibit. When you exit at the Terrace, don't forget to take in the view!
11.30 - 12.30	1	Walk along the Lakeside and visit the Walled Garden. We have lots of fruit/veg growing - especially in the Autumn. Don't forget to stop at our Himalayan Garden on the way.
12.30 - 1.00	all	Find a picnic spot or visit the cafe and have lunch. Toilets can be found near the Coach Park and in the Courtyard.
1.00 - 1.30	all	Walk up to our woodland area, Sylvascope. This woodland was cleared to promote biodiversity and build our amazing treehouse.
1.30 - 2.00	all	Walk to our historic church and check out our medieval tombs that date back to the Wars of the Roses!
2.00 - 2.30	all	Visit the Courtyard shop to pick up some souvenirs!
2.30 - 2.45	all	Walk up to the Coach Park, visit the toilets and prepare to leave.
