Seated beneath timeless masterpieces of the Italian Renaissance and surrounded by exquisite Georgian architecture, your guests will be immersed in a world of elegance and history.

Designed to be particularly spectacular during golden hour, the late afternoon sun reflects off the gilded Thomas Chippendale mirrors, creating a truly magical atmosphere as the day transitions into evening.

The Stewards Room

The Stewards Room is a playful and characterful location for civil ceremonies.

The room hosts some beautiful pieces from Harewood's French collection with shelves of porcelain and a classical fireplace.

The Hovels

If you're looking to add some rustic charm to your day, then take a look at the Hovels which can seat up to 80 guests, with catering supplied by Harewood Food & Drink Project.

The Courtyard

The Grade II listed Courtyard, with its inviting, arched entrance and grand, up-lit colonnades provides the ideal setting for celebrations for 150 guests into the evening. With access directly out onto the external Courtyard, the contemporary Stables offer indoor space to dance the night away.



The Hovels
